Our 2020 Multi-Week Development Programs

We are celebrating our 30th season of the Multi-Week Ski and Snowboard Development Programs. We're planning for another great season.

What is Offered When and for Whom?

- Jr. Dev. – Sat. & Sun. - Ages 6-10*
- Mtn. Explorers – Sat. & Sun. - Ages 11-16*
- Specialty Terrain Park Program – **Sat. and Weekend Session 2 only** - Ages 10-16* (must have helmet) and be an adv. skier/rider
- Adult Dev – Sat., Sun., and Weekend Session 2 with a minimum of 4 participants/class
- Women's Only Dev – **Sat. and Weekend Session 2**- limited to 21 intermediate-adv. female skiers

*Age by program start date

What Are the Program Dates?

- Sat. Session 1 starts on Jan. 4,11,25 and Feb. 1
- Sun.Session 1 starts on Jan. 5,12,26 and Feb. 2
- Weekend Session 3 runs on Feb. 22-23 and Feb.29-Mar. 1..
- **Note – there are NO make-up dates**

Parents, Why Let Kids Have All the Fun?

Consider joining one of our Adult Dev Classes. Bring your friends, or come and make new ones. With a minimum of 4 students/class our PSIA certified instructors will help you map out a plan to improve your personal skiing and try to keep up with your kids. You must at least be able to ride the Dipsy Quad and ski the green trails off of it for the Adult Dev. classes. Our female staff members are offering a "Women's Only" Dev program geared toward the intermediate to advanced female skier. Participants must be comfortable skiing the blue trails on the backside of the mountain.

- ALL Dev. Programs enjoy lift line cut privileges. Less time waiting in lines means more time on the slopes.
- Discounted Lessons – Think about this, a one hour class lesson is \$55, while for just a few dollars more per day, you get 5 hours of superb coaching. What an incredible value!

- Receiving terrain park coaching.
- Socializing – making friends that share your love of snowsports!
- Healthy dose of exercise and fun – a winning combination!
- We offer a \$10 family discount that applies to the 2nd, 3rd, & 4th persons enrolled in any of our Dev Programs.

What Happens When I Arrive?

When you arrive at Liberty in the morning, our Courtesy Staff will watch your skis or snowboards until 9:15 AM. There will be a Dev Program Ski Check sign to mark the area for your temporary early morning equipment check along the side of the Rental Shop exit. Boot bags and backpacks may be stowed in the Eastwind Room until the program ends at 3 PM. Please remember, your items are not totally secure unless they're in a locker. Lockers are available in the Ski Rental Shop, as well as the locker room behind the Boarderline Snowboard Rental Shop. If you are renting equipment, please report to the Eastwind Room for a rental form before heading downstairs. If you print an online rental form, you still need to bring it to the Eastwind Room and get it signed by Debbie, Danielle, Alan, Glenn or Chi or they will charge you when you go downstairs. If you do not have a season pass, you will get your lift ticket from your coach. No need to stand in line.

Interested in Leasing Equipment?

If you are interested in leasing equipment for the entire season, please call our retail shop early at 717-642-8143 for information and to reserve your equipment. This should be done before the resort opens for skiing in order to assure you the best selection.

Fun Yes, but Safety First!

Our coaches strive to find just the right mix of fun and learning. We operate under the umbrella of safety first. On the Dev Release Form, you will see a section that requires a parent's initials. Your signature is required to give your minor child permission to use the Freestyle Terrain Park during the lesson. As the kids increase their skill level, their coaches may take them through an introductory tour of the Terrain Park and try out some of the smaller features.

Special Requests...

On the application form, there is a section to list special requests. Please note that we will strive to accommodate your requests, but we can't always guarantee it. This is where you may request placement with a particular coach or to be placed with certain friends.

And Finally...

When we receive your payment and registration information, you will receive an email confirming that all of your necessary information has been received. Returning participants will be guaranteed a spot in **one of our sessions**, as long as we receive your registration with payment by **Oct. 15, 2019**. After that date, the program will be open to everyone on a first come, first served basis. If you are a new participant, you may send in your payment and registration **before Oct. 15**, but we will not assign you a spot, nor process your payment, until after that date. Your applications will be processed in the order in which they are received. When your payment has been processed, you will receive another email confirming your spot in the program.

Everyone registered in any of the Dev Programs will receive a letter from us in

December (for sessions starting in Jan.) and in early Feb. for session 2 starting on Feb. 22. It will contain your team assignment and important details regarding your session in the Dev. Program.
