



## ***Black Ski Hiking Trip Cedarville State Forest, Brandywine, MD Saturday – October 1, 2022 - 10:00 am***

Black Ski, Inc., (BSI) will hold its next nature hike at the Cedarville State Forest Park on Saturday, October 1<sup>st</sup>. Many of wooded area trails are fairly easy. We will head out from the Orange Trail which begins near the Park Office parking lot and hike from **4 to 7 miles**.

To participate, sign up by **September 30, 2022**, and complete the registration form online. Please read and follow the BSI's COVID-19 proof of vaccination requirements to participate in this event.

To prepare for your hike:

- Dress appropriately and wear fitted long pants, hiking or thick soles shoes, and a hat.
- The use of bug/tick spray is **highly** recommended.
- Carry water to stay hydrated.
- Hiking poles are suggested.

Once you've registered, **please meet the group by 10:00 am** on Saturday, October 1<sup>st</sup> at the parking area near the Park Office.

**Note on Google directions:** Visitors are advised not to follow directions to Cedarville State Forest using Google Maps since it may take you to the south end of the park where there is no entrance. However, if you use Google Maps, type in Dent Road and Bee Oak Road as the destination to get *correct* directions to the park entrance. The park's official address is the following:
